2024Critical Thinking Test

2024年度クリティカル・シンキング・テスト

Here is the results of the 2024 Critical Thinking Test (CTT). This was conducted using the CTT originally developed by MIU to measure the diploma policy of "DP1: Advanced thinking" of the School of International Liberal Arts. CT test was conducted on February 5th, 2025. The number of examinees was 54 (65.8%). Question sheets (23 questions. See example below) prepared in English were distributed and collected after the exam. Students chose the correct answer from four options and answered it in Google Forms.

2024 年度クリティカル・シンキング・テスト (CTT) の結果について報告します。これは、国際教養学部のディプロマ・ポリシー「DP1: 高度な思考力」を測定するために、本学が独自に開発した CTT を活用して実施するものです。3 年生(卒業研究1受講者82人)を対象に、2025年2月5 (水)に CT テストを実施した。テスト受験者数は54名(受験率65.8%)だった。英語で作成した問題用紙(23問、文末の例題を参照)を配布し、学生は4つの選択肢から正解を選び、Google Formsで解答した。問題用紙は試験終了後、回収した。

[Analysis]




Figure 1. Score distribution of CT Test 2024.

1) Figure 1 shows the distribution of the number of correct answers among the 23 questions. As in the previous years, there is a weak polarization. 図 1 に、23 問 中の正答数の分布を示す。昨年度、一昨年度のように弱い二極化が見られる。

2) Average percentage of correct answers is 46.5% (Number of correct answers were 10.7 among 23 questions), which is shown in Table 1 together with past results. This has decreased compared to recent results.

正答率の平均値は 46.5% (23 問中平均 10.7 問正答) であり、過去の結果 (表 1) との比較からここ数年に比べて低下した。

ach question correctly. The CTT consisted of seven CT elements ①~⑦. Table 3 shows the number of correct answers for each CT element. It was high in ① Identifying related information and low in ② Evaluating reliability of information. This trend has not changed significantly from last year.

表 2 に、各問の正答学生数を示す。CTT は 7 つの CT 要素①~⑦からなっている。表 3 には、CT 要素毎の正答数を示す。正答数は「①関連情報の見極め」が高く、「②情報の信頼性の評価」で低くなった。この傾向は、昨年度と大きな変化はない。

4) In the previous CT test for first-year students, the correct answer rate was about 38%, so it is judged that the critical thinking ability has been improved in three years of study.

以前に実施した1年生対象のCTテストでは、正答率は38%程度だったことから、3年間の学修でクリティカル・シンキング能力は向上していると判断される。

Question 1. According to scientists, a fruit has seeds. A fruit develops from part of a plant's flower called an ovary. By comparison, a vegetable does not develop from a flower. A vegetable is a plant's root, stem, or leaf. According to scientists, is an eggplant a fruit or vegetable?

- a) An eggplant is a vegetable because you must cook it before you eat it.
- b) An eggplant is a fruit because it develops from a flower's ovary.
- c) An eggplant is a vegetable because its seeds are small enough to eat.
- d) An eggplant is a fruit because it grows above the ground.
