

Question 3

Read the passage and answer the following questions. (45 points)

New High-tech Money in Japan

In July 2024, Japan will introduce new bank notes that look different and use advanced technology to prevent people from making fake money. These new bills will feature holograms that make the images of historical figures appear three-dimensional, which is a first for bank notes worldwide.

One of the new bills, the 10,000-yen note, will showcase Eiichi Shibusawa, known as the "father of Japanese capitalism." Shibusawa played a key role in founding Japan's first national bank and several major companies. This change marks the first time the portrait on the 10,000-yen note has been updated since 1984. The back of this note will display an image of Tokyo Station.

The 5,000-yen note will honor Umeko Tsuda, who founded Tsuda University and advocated for women's education in Japan. On its reverse side, there will be a depiction of flowers. Meanwhile, the 1,000-yen note will feature Shibasaburo Kitasato, a pioneer in Japanese medicine. The back of this note will showcase the famous woodblock print "Under the Well of the Great Wave off Kanagawa" by Hokusai Katsushika.

These changes were first announced in April 2019 by former Finance Minister Taro Aso, aligning with Japan's tradition of redesigning bank notes about every 20 years. Aso explained that the designs were chosen to reflect cultural and economic figures from the Meiji era onward (1868-1912). The introduction of holographic technology in the new bills (1), making the portraits stand out with a 3D effect. In addition to their visual updates, the new bills will be the same size as the previous designs and will incorporate the numbers more prominently than kanji characters for the amount. This adjustment aims to improve accessibility, especially for people with visual disabilities.

While the 2,000-yen note will not receive a redesign, all current bank notes, including it, can still be used after the new bills enter circulation. However, ATMs and vending machines will need updates to handle the new notes, prompting some businesses to promote cashless payments to reduce the need for such changes.
