- ③ 感染者が出た学校は3日間休校。感染者・濃厚接触者が利用した施設(教室・研究室等)の消毒。活動範囲(学科・クラス等)を特定し、休校の延長等を検討する。

- * 1 : Decisions regarding the junior high and high school will be made on a case-by-case basis in accordance with the actions taken by surrounding schools and the prefectural board of education.
- * 2 : Employees required for unavoidable reasons to travel to outbreak areas for business will telework or stay home for 3 days upon return (requires submission of request for exemption from full-time duties)
- Employees required to travel to outbreak areas for unavoidable personal reasons will telework or stay home for 3 days upon return (requires submission of request for exemption from full-time duties). Failure to report such travel in advance will result in a notice of stern warning.
- OTHER: The Miyazaki Gakuen Library will not be open to the community until warning returns to Level 0, and the new coronavirus infection is contained.

♦ If an infected person or a person who has had concentrated contact with such person appears on campus

- 1 For infected persons (including those who do not have symptoms), attendance at school (work) will be suspended (students will not be treated as absent. Faculty and staff will be processed as sick leave)
- Those who have had concentrated contact with an infected person (including those who do not have symptoms) will be required to stay home for 2 weeks until health monitoring period is complete. (students will not be treated as absent. Faculty and staff will be processed as exemption from full-time duties)
- Schools where infection occurs on campus will be closed for 3 days. All facilities (classrooms, laboratories, etc.) used by infected persons or by those who have had concentrated contact with an infected person will be disinfected. The scope of such person's activities will be determined (department, classes, etc.) and consideration will be given to extending school closure.
